- To create awareness about the cost-effectiveness of water conservation projects among students and local communities.
- To organize various outreach programmes under the leadership of NSS for clean and safe potable water.
- To promote students to monitor and collect information related to water bodies and their pollution of nearby areas.

Action Plan:

- Enhance the efficiency of plumbing fixtures, thereby minimising potable water use.
- Install sensor fittings in toilets.
- Reusing RO drain water for vessel washing.
- Prepare rainwater recharge pit.
- Install water-meter to improve the water performance of the building, and thereby save potable water
