MSAJAA POSH CELL – POLICY DOCUMENT

Introduction

MSAJAA is dedicated to providing a secure atmosphere for all individuals, with a particular focus on female students and employees. Everyone is entitled to decent treatment and respect. There is no room for sexual harassment in college. Thus, POSH policy refers to the rules and processes that Indian enterprises must adhere to in order to comply with the legislation. The College formed an Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) in accordance with the POSH Act to look into allegations of sexual harassment.

The committee has regular meetings to raise awareness of safety measures to be taken on college property to protect women and female students. It also thoroughly investigates cases of sexual harassment. The committee will protect the privacy and anonymity of those who complain and those who are accused. Enquiry procedures will ensure that complainants, witnesses, and the harasser are not subjected to victimization or discrimination.

Statutory norms followed by MSAJAA

- Gender Sensitization, Prevention and Prohibition of Sexual Harassment of Women Employees and Students and Redressal of Grievances in Technical
- Institutional community aware of the information on the mechanism put in place for Redressal of complaints pertaining to sexual harassment, contact details of members of Internal Complaints Committee, complaints procedure and so on
- Organise Training Programmes to sensitize them and ensure knowledge and awareness of the rights, entitlements and responsibilities enshrined in the Act and under these regulations
- Act decisively against all gender based violence perpetrated against employees and students of all sexes
- Internal Committee (IC) with an inbuilt mechanism for gender sensitization against sexual harassment. The IC shall have the following composition:

A Presiding Officer who shall be a woman Faculty member employed at a senior Level (not below a Professor in case of a University, and not below an Associate Professor in case of an Institution) at the Educational Institution, nominated by the Executive Authority

One Faculty members and one non-teaching employees, preferably committed to the cause of women or who have had experience in social work or have legal knowledge, nominated by the Executive Authority

Three students (comprising of at least one girl student) of Pre-Final/Final year at Undergraduate At least one-half of the total members of the IC shall be women.

ABOUT THE COMMITTEE

In order to create and maintain a community in which teaching, non-teaching staff and Students can work together in an environment free of sexual violence, harassment, exploitation, and intimidation, MSAJAA has proactively established a cell for Prevention of Sexual Harassment (POSH) under the recommendation of the National Accreditation and Assessment Council. This includes all forms of gender violence, sexual harassment, and discrimination on the basis of sex/gender.

ROLE OF THE COMMITTEE:

- Prevent discrimination and sexual harassment against women, by promoting gender amity among students and employees
- Deal with cases of discrimination and sexual harassment against women, in a time bound manner, aiming at ensuring support services to the victimized and termination of the harassment
- To ensure that appropriate action is taken against the offender
- To ensure that victims and witnesses are not victimized or discriminated because of their complaint.
- To take proactive measures towards sensitization of the working and learning community on gender issues so that the institution is an excellent work place for all.
- Recommend appropriate punitive action against the guilty party to the cell.

PROCEDURE OF THE COMMITTEE

- 1) The victim should make a formal written complaint to the chairperson of the Internal Complaint Committee/ POSH Committee preferably within 15 days from the date of occurrence of the alleged incident. Alternately, the employee can send complaint through an email. The employee is required to disclose her name, department, she is working in, to enable the chairperson to contact her and take the matter forward.
- 2) The complaint is filed under Internal Complaint Committee/ POSH Committee. Chairman of Internal Complaint Committee/ POSH Committee starts its investigation procedure. Necessary evidences related to the complaint case are collected. Oral & then written statements are taken from the applicant as well as the alleged offender and the witnesses.
- 3) The chairperson will proceed to determine whether the allegations made in the complaint fall under the purview of Sexual Harassment. In case the accused is found guilty, committee may recommend appropriate punitive action to be undertaken by the Director.
- 4) Punitive action could be in the nature of transfer, termination, slash the remuneration, consideration in annual performance appraisal, and demand for an apology to the victim, or any other. The decision for punishment will be based on the impact of the harassment on the recipient of the same.
- 5) Efforts must be made to resolve the dispute through counseling. If required, the Institutional management may refer the complainant to a lawyer to lodge a complaint with the concerned police station.
- 6) Confidentiality will be maintained throughout any investigatory process. All records of complaints, including contents of meetings, results of investigations and other relevant material will be kept confidential except where disclosure is required under disciplinary or other remedial processes



Event Description : Sexual harassment is an unwelcome sexual behaviour that's offensive, humiliating or intimidating. It can be written, verbal or physical, and can happen in person or online. Anybody can experience sexual harassment, regardless of their gender. When it happens at work, school or university, sexual harassment may amount to a form of discrimination.

The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act was passed in 2013, defining sexual harassment, laying down the procedures for a complaint and inquiry, and the action to be taken. Prevention of workplace sexual harassment continues to gain traction in spite of the Covid-19 lockdown and employees working remotely. It mandated that every employer must constitute an Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) at each office or branch with 10 or more employees.

With this Background and at the behest of Tamil Nadu State Government's Guidelines and the encouragement of Anna University's POSH cell regarding the issue of sexual harassment, an ICC has been constituted at MSAJAA to spread awareness in students and staff thereby preventing any occurences on our campus. 


GENDER EQUITY & SENSITIZATION IN CURRICULUM

PROJECT BRIEF - TIME PROBLEM- ACCESS TO THE MARINA BEACH

PROJECT INTRODUCTION

1. The live is India's first permanent ramp for persons with disabilities on a beach .A stretch of the Marina Beach area was proposed to be made accessible to differently-abled persons as an initiative by the Greater Chennai Corporation in association with the Disability Rights Alliance TN, an annual affair since 2016.

An exclusive permanent pathway for persons with disabilities was proposed at the Marina and announced in the Assembly for the development of the pathway, among infrastructure projects for the year 2022-23. The 3-metre-wide pathway leads to a 22metre-wide deck for disabled people and senior citizens to view the sea. Supporting amenities and facilities such as accessible toilets, ocean ramp, trained assistants at the 'May I Help You' disability assistance booth linked with a maintenance contractor, portable beach mats, amphibious wheelchairs with seat belts, CRZ-compliant container for beach wheelchairs, and life jackets are needed. MobiMats, parking and crossing floor marking, smart pole with CCTV, multimodal communication, safety flags, disability-specific lifeguard training, scoop stretcher, other retrofits from drinking water to first aid booths to other amenities, tactile guidance from closest public transport, removing blocking bollards and accessible tourism tie-in with surrounding.

Project Intention:

- 1.To understand universal design and design with inclusiveness for the disabled people by understanding the international classification of impairments Disabilities and Handicaps. To understand different types of physical mobility and decode the difficulties faced by disabled through empathy mapping
- 2. The design of an open and free environment which inspires disabled and senior citizens to visit the beach and provide facilities to make the beach accessible to all. Students explore design solutions understanding the appropriate architecture after discussion with the specific user group-Disabled and NGO.
- 3. Spatial design considers the individual needs of each disabled, and dives deep into how they move and interact within a space (much like experiential design), as well as how their needs might change and evolve over time.

Project Brief:

This project requires students to propose a 22-metre-long walkway to access the beach accommodating several related functions such as help desk, Seating/Relaxing spaces, Changing rooms and toilets, Play area for disabled children Food spaces and cafes.


